The course is based on a shared learning process between the participants. Each session is an important part of the process and we hope that everyone can participate in all of the five sessions.



**PARTICIPANTS:** Teachers or other educational professionals from early childhood education and care to upper secondary education who want to increase their competence on how to tackle discrimination in school environment. The training is in English with trainers and participants from Finland, Estonia and Slovenia. For best learning results, it is recommended that two or more participants would work in the same school or have other possibilities for cooperation on local level.

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** The course provides the participants methods, tools and theoretical information about how to tackle discrimination in school environment. The SAFER course focuses on the school culture and environment, giving the participants skills and competences to be able to create safer spaces, build equality and introduce antiracist practices in their work. Course is organized as online training.

The course is suitable for all educators or other professionals from early childhood education and care to upper secondary education, who work at school environment. In addition to the trainings, the participants will get a learning diary which includes information and exercises. This material is developed in SAFER-project.

**The course is free for participants.**

The objectives of the SAFER course:

- Introduce innovative co-creative approaches for dealing constructively with issues of discrimination, hate speech and racism in school.
- Finding tools how teachers can create safer space for social transformation in schools.
- To empower teachers to recognize, manage and transform discriminatory factors in school.
- Find tools to support safety and wellbeing of minority students.
- Deepening the knowledge about discrimination and transforming schools (theory and sharing good practices).
- Key concepts: discrimination, antiracism, hate speech, intersectionality, transforming schools, safer space, equality, equity.
